We will leave by coach from Lancashire on Sunday 26th November 2017, in time to arrive at Packwood Hall, Lapworth, Warwickshire by 12.00 noon. Here we will be split into two groups with entry to the house with a guided tour at 12.00pm and 1.00pm with the later group having lunch first and the first group having lunch after the house visit. You can take your own packed lunch if you prefer.

Packwood Hall is a much-restored Tudor house, park and garden with notable topiary. The culmination of a lifetime of dreams: salvaged objects and exotic pieces come together in a Jacobean meets Edwardian style. Beautiful, homely, warm and welcoming. We can't put it better than a visitor in the 1920s did: A house to dream of, a garden to dream in. The house was originally built in the 16th century, yet its interiors were extensively restored between the First and Second World Wars by Graham Baron Ash to create a fascinating 20th-century evocation of domestic Tudor architecture. Packwood House contains a fine collection of 16th-century textiles and furniture, and the gardens have renowned herbaceous borders and a famous collection of yews.
